NATIONAL AVERAGE SALARY:

DEGREES:

- **Bachelor's Degree** in English or related field
- **Master's Degree** in English or related field
- **PhD Degree** in English, English Education, Composition & Rhetoric, or Linguistics
- **MFA Degree** for Creative Writers

EXPECTATIONS:

- Specialization in a specific concentration, such as 18th-century British Literature, Composition & Rhetoric, or Linguistics
- The ability to conduct academic research and regularly publish peer-reviewed articles or books
- Academic citizenship through participation in faculty committees and mentoring of students

University English Professor

University English Professors develop and teach courses in their area(s) of specialty, while also actively engaging in scholarly research and writing. The latter often includes presenting at academic conferences, publishing in peer-reviewed journals, or producing scholarly monographs in their area(s) of specialty. University professors are also expected to teach a full course load (often 3 to 4 classes per semester) and assume regular service responsibilities (serving on faculty committees, holding leadership roles in the department, etc.). A PhD is required to become a university English professor, and universities hire candidates whose specializations best fit the needs of the department. Thus, university professors should have a passion not only for teaching, but also for scholarship and publishing in their respective fields.
